Judy, a former manager of the Humane Society, told me this heartwarming story of a dog rescue.

A house fire left a family with nothing but themselves and one of their pet dogs. An ex-spouse agreed to take care of the dog until they could get settled into a new home, but reported that the dog had run away and was hit and killed by a car. After getting settled, they went to the Humane Society to get a couple of cats to replace the ones who'd died in the fire. While the paperwork was being done, the man went out back to look at the dogs in the runs and recognized their dog. He grabbed his wife to show her, and the exuberance of the dog made it clear to Judy that not only did the man recognize his dog, but the dog recognized his previous owners. The only problem was that someone had already adopted the dog and was picking it up in a few hours.

Judy made some quick calls, and a very happy ending was the result. The woman who'd adopted their dog liked another dog just as well as the

family's dog and decided to take that one once she heard the story, and the family was able to take their pet home with their two new cats.

This story reminded me of **BOMBO**, where the owner was separated from his dog, Bombo, through no fault of his own. In his case, it took Robin Kould and Mary Yen to straighten things out so Greg and Bombo could be reunited. They weren't nearly so adept at this as Judy, though.
